	 Cllr. Pringle also attended recent training on taxi licensing, which covered 					
	regulatory updates and enforcement practices.

	Councillors received a proposal to consider the development of three key strategic

	Plan. It was proposed that all three documents be incorporated into the Council's 3-Year					
	Strategic Plan. Following discussion, members approved the proposal with the					
	amendment that the Parish Emergency Plan be prioritised and developed first.

	Members discussed ongoing concerns regarding unpleasant odours emanating from the					
	nearby industrial estate, which have been affecting residents in Trowell. It was agreed

	these incidents effectively. Members resolved to inform residents of the correct					
	procedure for reporting odour complaints directly to the Environment Agency. Residents					
	should be advised to obtain and retain the incident reference number provided upon					
	reporting. Furthermore, it was agreed that residents should forward this reference					
	number and a brief description of the incident to the local odour complaints coordinator,					
	to assist in tracking and escalating the issue where necessary.
